

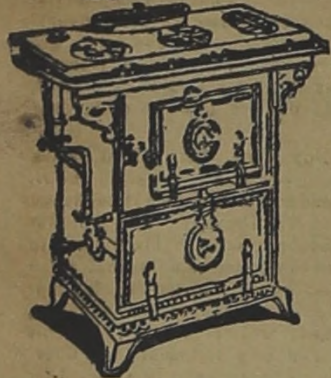

At Bradford yesterday Mr. John Hedge, of Manchester presided over the annual conference of the Labour Representation Committee. The proceedings were chiefly remarkable for a lively attack upon Mr. Richard Bell, M.P., with reference to certain action he had taken at the Norwich by-election.

Canon MacColl, well known as having been the intimate friend of Mr. Gladstone, was yesterday married, at St. Mary Abbots Church, Kensington, to Miss Consuelo Albina Crompton-Stansfield.

Speaking yesterday at a meeting held in support of the Social Institute Union, Lord Brassey strongly advocated its aims, which are to promote self-supporting clubs, furnishing recreation to working men and women, thus counteracting the evil influences of the public house.

Southwark's Board of Guardians, in pursuance of the complaints they have recently made as to the treatment meted out to certain patients at Guy's Hospital, have determined to lay the matter in question before the King Edward Hospital Fund Committee and the Hospital Sunday Fund.

Before the Manchester Stipendiary yesterday the Newspaper Syndicate, Limited, proprietors of the "Weekly Dispatch," were summoned for aiding, abetting, counselling, and procuring the commission of wilful damage to the highway, the cases arising out of the search for hidden treasure. The Court held that a person who put in a paper an advertisement was responsible for all reasonable consequences of his own act. They ordered the defendants to pay a shilling damages, a fine of £5, and ten shillings costs. Mr. Muir, for the defendants, said he would advise his clients not to pay the fine, but to leave the Court to find out how to enforce it, in order to raise the point of law.

When the hearing of the action against the Yorkshire Miner's Association for £150,000 damages for alleged conspiracy was continued yesterday, Mr. Rufus Isaacs submitted that on the case presented by the plaintiff colliery owners there was no question of fact to be tried. Mr. Justice Lawrence decided that the case must go to the jury.

James William Brown, an Island Revenue officer, recovered £100 damages in the King's Bench Division yesterday against an eating-house proprietor who had assaulted him when he called for the purpose of serving a summons and another legal document.

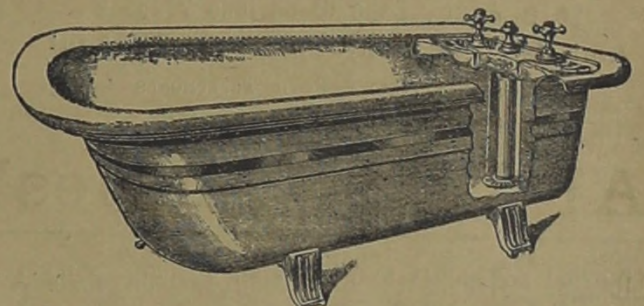

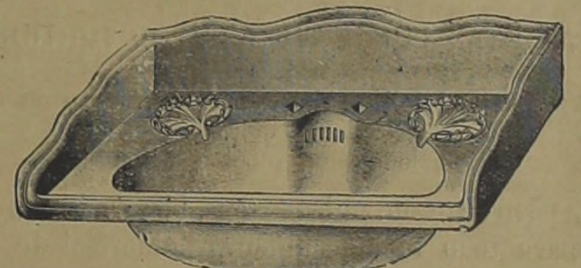
