Saints Cornelius and Cyprian. — William Blackwood, publisher, died, 1834. — 259 days past, 106 to the end of the year.

Three characteristic appreciations of H. R. Highness's reception in South America.

Mr. Chamberlain, on behalf of Great Britain and the British delegation to the Assembly of the League of Nations said:

"We have watched with interest the course of the Prince of Wales's journey, and greatly appreciate the cordiality of the reception everywhere met at the hands of the authorities and the public."

Lord Cecil said: "The British public have received with profound interest the accounts of the visit of the Prince of Wales throughout the several countries of South America. They have been touched by the great kindness indeed enthusiasm, with which he has been received. The sympathy between Great Britain and the countries in question is well known, and naturally an event like this, which shows that the inhabitants of those countries are also friendly disposed to the British Empire has been received with the greatest possible satisfaction."

Mr. Ramsay MacDonald told a Press representative that "we have read with appreciative interest the newspaper accounts of the hearty reception given the Prince of Wales in South America. I hope that the result will be to draw the peoples closer together and establish that harmony of mind and purpose which the world needs so much to day."

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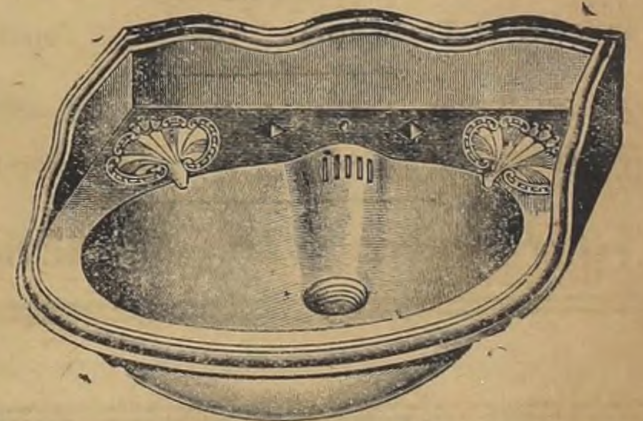

Death of Sir John Jordan, Dr. Carter, Professor Clay.

Cables from London announce the death of Sir John Jordan formerly British Minister in Pekin and a Member of Assessors Commission of the League of Nations who died suddenly at a Meeting of the Chinese Association.

From Washington comes a cable reporting the death of Dr. Carter who had been nominated for Nobel Prize on account of his discoveries in reference to yellow fever.

The National Administrative Council.

In the National Council on Monday the question of the importation of cattle was discussed in the presence of the Ministers of Industry and Finance, with a view to considering the motion presented last Friday by Sr. Terra in the sense of derogating

Decree of 17 Sep. 1920 concerning the importation of cattle. After much discussion it was agreed to derogate the Decree in the following terms:

"The National Council of Administration, decree: Art. 1. Let the Decree of 17th September 1920, that prohibits the importation of live stock and forage from the Argentine Republic be derogated.

Art. 2. The importation of live stock in general from that country is authorized under the conditions of the Decrees of 10th of January and 14th March 1921 and other regulations in force.

Art. 3. The National Inspection of Animal Sanitary Police, in agreement with the Minister of Industries will authorize the local where the sanitary observation should take place."

The pension asked for by Dr. Lepayre, was granted unanimously and it was also agreed that the Council should be represented at the Institute "José Enrique Rodó" when Dr. Lepayre handed it over to his successor.

Homage to the late Captain de Navio, Francisco P. Miranda

Miranda, for many years a highly appreciated professor at the School, a bronze tablet with an artistic design with a view of the sea where the late esteemed official, many years ago, met with a serious accident while fulfilling his duty on board the gunboat "General Rivera." An eloquent oration was delivered before the tomb by Dr. Bargo.

His wife is accompanying him upon the expedition.

War on Parasites.

Announcement was made to-day to the effect that the Italian Government has decided to appropriate about 3,000,000 lire for the purpose of fighting plant and tree parasites which are estimated to cause a damage of approximately 6,000,000,000 lire per annum.

The parasites are calculated to ruin the olive crop alone to the extent of 600,000,000 lire each year.

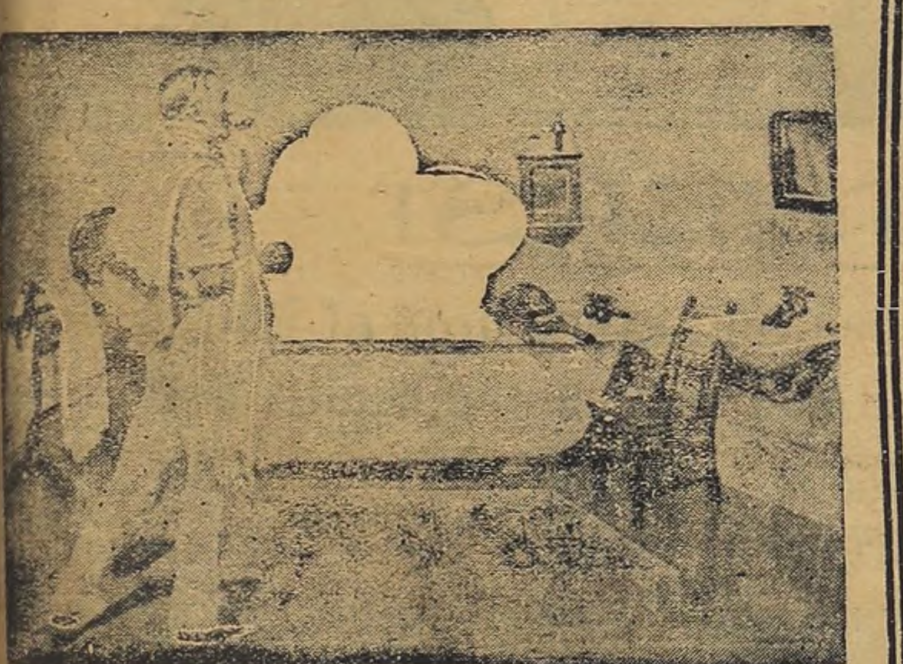

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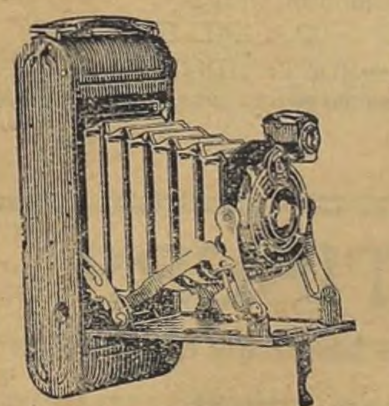

Legislative and Administrative Notes.

In the Ministry of Public Works, a meeting took place of the Special Commission nominated by the Consejo Nacional to report on a proposed Railway Regulation Bill. A Commission to prepare the Report was formed, consisting of Señores Luis Ronco, Raul Regules, Guillermo and Mr. C. W. Bayne C. B. E. The Consejo Nacional considered the question of the international trade in cattle. It was decided to send the Decree of September 17 (which forbade the importation of cattle and forage) so as to allow further decision the free importation of cattle from the Argentine. The Chamber of Deputies continued the debate in detail of the Women's Rights Bill. The alterations clauses 105 107, 108, 1 9, 112, 116, 123 and 129 of the Civil Code, which are necessary to give effect to the Bill, were approved. In the first October Session the State will consider Dr. Cima's Bill to Regulate Female and Child Labor.

The Shenandoah disaster and air defence.

Mr. Wilbur has nominated a Commission headed by Rear Admiral Hilary to enquire into the causes of the "Shenandoah" disaster. President Hodge has appointed a board of inquiry to investigate the nation's air defence, and Senator Borah has gone to Washington to attend the next Congress in which he will conduct an inquiry into the Government's aviation policy with reference to the charges made by Colonel Mitchell.

London Notes.

August 19

The cost to the nation of the bread subsidy is state in the second report of the Royal Commission on Wheat supplies to be about £128 000,000.

Sr. Philip Sassoon, Under-Secretary for Air inspected the Training School for aircraft apprentices at Halton yesterday, on the occasion of the passing out of 684 apprentices.

Sr. L. Worthington-Evans, Secretary for War, speaking at Shotton last night, defended the policy of the Government in granting a temporary subsidy to the coal industry and said he did not believe that the peace which had been obtained was necessarily temporary.

The Maharaja of Patiala paid visits yesterday to the Salvation Army Headquarters in Queen Victoria-street and to the Men's Hostel in Old-street.

The St. Paul's Cathedral Preservation Fund now amounts to £249,986.

At a meeting of the Scottish flax trade held in Dundee yesterday, attended by representatives of the flax and linen trades from Ireland, it was agreed to apply to the Board of Trade for the imposition of a duty for the safeguarding of the industry.

A letter has been addressed to the Treasury by the Association of Municipal Corporations protesting against the application of any part of the Road Fund to purposes other

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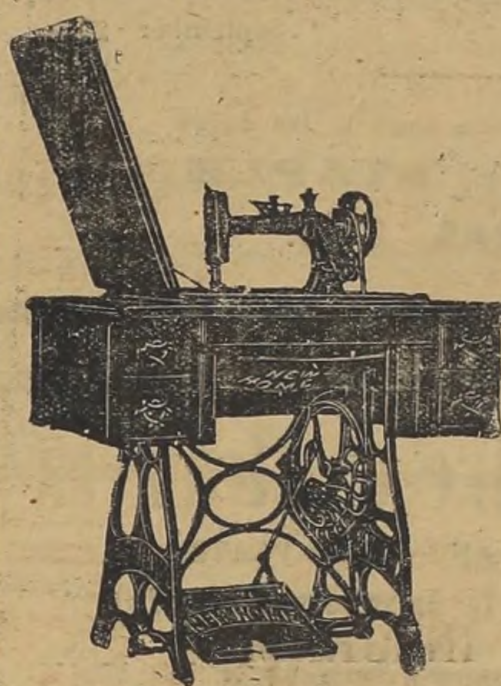
