News of the Day.

HOLIDAY.

To-day being a general public holiday, THE MONTEVIDEO TIMES will not appear again until Saturday.

H. R. H. the Prince of Wales returns to B. Aires.

H. R. H. the Prince of Wales arrived at Retiro Pacific station at 10 p. m. on Monday night. It had been raining heavily, so there was not such a crowd there as there would have been had the weather been fine.

The Prince of Wales was received on the platform by Dr. Gallardo, the Minister of Foreign Affairs, on behalf of the Government, while other high Argentine officials at the station to greet him were General Vaccarezza, Admirals Fleiss and Dairreux, the Sub-Director of Police, Mr. Martinez de Hoz, etc. The British Minister and Lady Alston and several members of the Legation, and Mr. Middle, of the B. A. P., were also at the station to meet His Royal Highness.

H. R. Highness first returned to the Basualdo Mansion and then went to the Legation and afterwards attended a dance at Sr. Horacio Sanchez Elia's house held in honour of his return.

The Prince's programme for Tuesday was to include his attendance at the San Martin Theatre in the evening in order to accept the homage prepared by the 'Comité Popular Argentino de Recepción al Príncipe de Gales.'

This will include the presentation of the painting entitled 'Veros en el de Mayo'; and the gifts of bronze which will be presented on the British Clock Tower, in the Chamber of Commerce, and on 'The Standard' premises.

H. R. Highness was to leave Buenos Aires on Wednesday afternoon, 16 o'clock, to spend a couple of days at Chapadmalal before embarking on the Repulse.

The President of the Republic will go to Mar del Plata to bid well to the Prince on board the Repulse. Dr. Alvear will leave by special train early on Saturday morning, accompanied by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Marine and Public Works, the President of the Reception Committee and other personalities.

According to information supplied last night by the Chancery, the Prince of Wales will give a banquet in honour of the President of the Republic on Saturday, on board of the Repulse, which will leave on Sunday morning on its return voyage to England.

The Influence of the Moving Pictures.

The influence of the Moving Pictures in Montevideo is very great. It is a cheap entertainment and unfortunately attracts young people so strongly that they neglect studies, work or other amusements to go to the *Cine*. Once the habit is acquired it becomes a vice that cannot be overcome. Children or young people who have been promised to go to the *Cine*, if bad weather or anything else prevents the fulfilment of the promise, become irritable and unbearable, they cannot turn their mind to anything else.

This being so, it is much to be regretted that so often such poor stuff is shown, and also such bad stuff. There is a very large share of the nature of the monkey still in human beings, and like the monkey they possess great powers of imitation. Girls in their dressing, in their movements, in their vulgarities copy the patterns set by the 'movies'. Boys in their pretensions, their insolence their lack of respect, the facility with which they would use firearms and would 'hold up' unfortunate people, copy the American 'cow-boy' style of hero. Bad taste and bad form are easily acquired.

Instead of saying more on this subject we will quote what an educated Chinese said about the 'Movies' in Peking.

He writes: 'I think I can say a great deal unfavourably about the American films in China. Most of the pictures give an unfavourable impression of American daily life, for instance the numerous reels of long detective and mystery stories, cheap love affairs, dress for the sake of extreme undress of the gentle sex, craze for almighty dollars.'

'The fundamental truth is that every film produced in the West has a different effect when displayed in the Orient. In India I found that the Police Commissioners viewed the matter with the greatest seriousness. One ex-Police Commissioner said to me: 'If Western influence declines in the Orient, I think it will largely be due to the intrusion of the moving pictures.'

'The Oriental may not be moral according to our Western standards, but he has a conception of modesty which we have long ago lost. He once respected Western women because he knew nothing about them, and he respected Western men because they seemed capable of protecting women. Today he thinks that from the film he has learnt everything about Western women; he regards them as all immodest and his contempt for Western life is profound.'

'Would it be impossible for the United States Government to send a special Commission to the Orient to examine the effect of films there and then to set up a special censorship on the exportation of films? One remembers that the United

States Government was once very interested in opium, and films do more harm than opium out East to-day.'

The Situation in Australia.

The following important statement is cabled from Melbourne:

Mr. Seale, Deputy Chairman of the Overseas Shipping Representatives' Association, issued the following statement to the Australian members of the Seamen's Union:

'If we had wished to force the issue, we could have precipitated an upheaval that would have plunged Australia temporarily into the melting pot, and provoked a chaos of sinister influences.'

'We do not believe, however, in the 'damn Australia' and 'damn the Empire' policy of the Communist agitators, but if the present conditions continue, Australia will face an economic disaster of wide spread unemployment.'

'Even if the British ships were manned to-morrow, there would still be weeks and months of dislocation ahead. The strike is a deliberate revolt against Unionists' constitutional methods, and against the police of the leaders of English Labour.'

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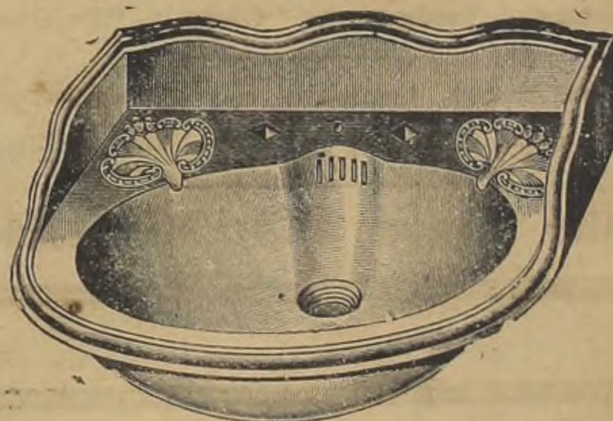

Homage to Dr. Zorrilla de San Martin.

The National Committee organized to collect subscriptions to acquire a house to be presented to the great national poet, orator and writer, Dr. Zorrilla de San Martin, met under the Presidency of Dr. Elias Regules, and decided that subscriptions should be collected during the month of October and that the collection should finish on the 31st of that month. As we mentioned yesterday the amount already subscribed is \$15,200.

Bridges Rio Negro.

The «estancieros» of the Department of Rio Negro are delighted with the news that the law has been passed authorizing the Executive Power to dispose of a large sum of money in the construction of bridges in their Department. Of course they will have to provide some money themselves to enable the bridges to be built; but we understand that has

already been arranged for and all land owners are pleased with the prospect new bridges will open in their Department.

The League of Nations

As any modification of the statutes of the International Court might interfere with the adhesion of the United States, the Uruguayan Delegates to the Assembly have withdrawn the proposed revision.

With regard to the Mosul question the British Delegates laid a note before the Assembly advising that the treatment of the Christians by the Turks was a violation of the Treaty of Lausanne.

Campaign against Cabarets.

In London Father Degen, a popular Catholic priest has commenced a campaign against cabarets, as scenes of degraded orgies. He compares the present day cabaret with the debauches of ancient Rome and urged that London should be freed from such places.

It would be well if Father Degen would visit the River Plate.

Lady Huntworth's Experiment.

Mr. Allan M. McDonald, manager of the house of William Cooper and Nephews Ltd., leaves for Salto and other interior towns on Friday.

On his return, he has kindly promised to supply us with news concerning the state of camps,

cattle, agriculture, etc. which from so keen an observer will be invaluable.

The New Year Lottery.

The Lottery Board have decided to make the big drawing for the end of the year a combination of 3,000 prizes, of which the highest will be \$500,000, with a second of \$100,000 and third of \$50,000. Twenty thousand tickets will be issued at \$100 each, divided into «decimos».

New Branch Bank

The Bank of the Republic in view of the growing importance of the suburb of Piedras has decided to open a branch in that district.

Salesmen in Convention.

The dealers of a certain mark of automobile were prominent on Tuesday afternoon parading the streets of the city with a procession of forty cars to let the public know by ocular demonstration of their special make being in active service of the country. Later they had a jollification in one of the hotels, and were successful in obtaining any amount of newspaper publicity for what was purely a business enterprise of a private nature.

Still the «Sao Paulo».

The men who for the last ten months have been living in Montevideo at the expense of the Brazilian Government, after abandoning the warship «Sao Paulo» in which they arrived as revolutionists last year, having been notified that they would no longer be supported by the local Brazilian Authorities, decided to move to the neighbouring State of Rio Grande, and were detected conveying a large train of munitions and arms from one of the stations on the Eastern railway, to which place it had been shipped as cases of agricul-

tural machinery. This is the second attempt in recent times of Brazilian irreconcilables to run armaments through this republic without success.

The Proposed Loan.

The Consejo de Estado are still discussing the terms on which the Government should ask for a 45,000,000 loan from American bankers, and more particularly the objects which should figure as the attractions for the lenders to invest their capital in Uruguayan bonds. Port extension, Rio Negro power and irrigation schemes, new railways, etc., offering revenue as some guarantee for the interest charged, are all being talked of, and in political circles the arrangement of the loan appears to be taken as a foregone conclusion.

Visitor.

Bishop Dobbs, of the Methodist Church South, is expected to arrive by this morning's train from Rivera, and will spend some days in the city as the guest of Mrs. H. P. Coates.

Bishop Dobbs has charge of the work of his Church in the republic of Brazil, and has been holding the various Conferences in different cities between San Paulo and Porto Alegre.

The Rector of the University.

The President of the National Administration Council, Dr de Herrera, laid a motion before said Council on Tuesday to the effect that a Message should be presented to Parliament modifying the present mode of appointing the Rector of the University.

His proposal is that the Message should recommend that the appointment must be made by the University, only and exclusively, by the free votes of the students. The initiative of Dr de Herrera has been passed to the Minister of Public Instruction Dr. Carlos M. Prado to be studied.

Electoral reform.

In the National Club there was a meeting of the Directors and representatives to discuss this question. After much discussion it was resolved to declare that the Nationalists had agreed with the Bat-

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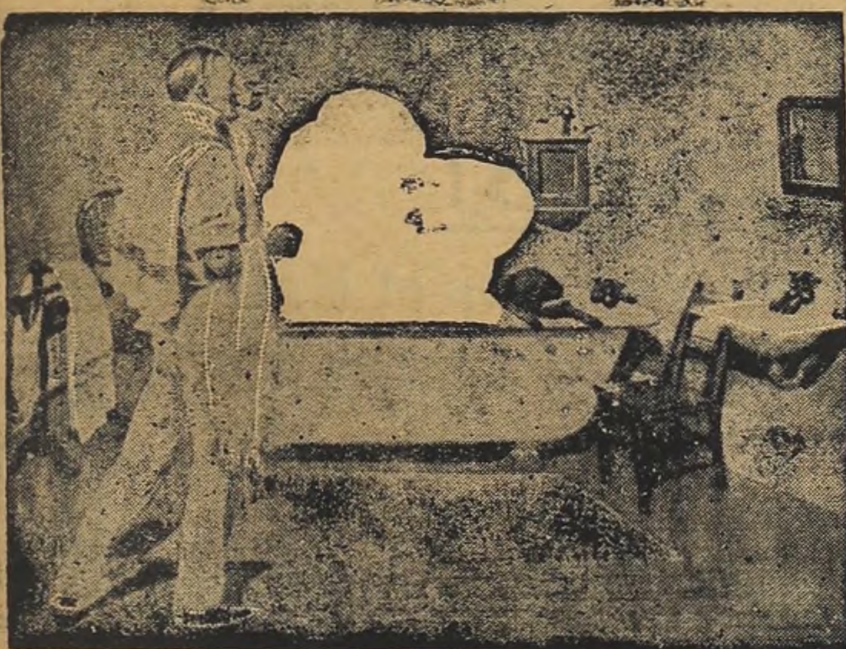

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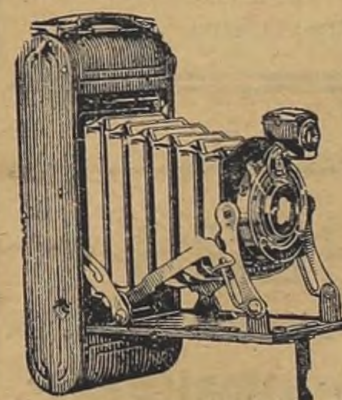

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lists to accept some of the formulas proposed in which the system of D'Hondt is applied to the election of the members of the Departmental Government. The various formulas were then discussed and it was agreed to accept with slight modifications the formula (A) proposed by Dr. Ghigliani in the name of Batllism. Finally it was resolved to authorize the delegates to the 25 to carry out the negotiations with the Batllistas to convert into law said formula. Drs. Roxlo, Aguirre and Rodriguez Larreta did not accept the part referring to the declaration respecting the pact with the Batllistas.

Ports on the Uruguay.

The Director of Hydrographics, Engineer Felix A. Bruno, insists that four large ports should be constructed on the Uruguay River, namely: Salto, Paysandú, Fray Bentos and Nueva Palmira. Up to Paysandú ocean steamers can come, and from the mouth of the Uruguay to this point three of the large ports can be established.

From the Paysandú to Salto ocean steamers cannot be used. He then suggests what is necessary to complete these ports.

Tree Protection.

We call attention to a preparation called *Tactite* imported by William Cooper & Nephews Ltd., the well known manufacturers of Veterinary and Horticultural remedies. A small band of *Tactite* placed around the trunk of tree or shrub will effectively prevent ants from climbing up and destroying the young foliage. We understand that this preparation has given excellent results in protecting new tree plantations.

Overseas Items.

The Seamen's strike in South Africa continues and is causing serious losses to the Cape fruit growers unable to export their products.

The United States authorities are talking of deporting aliens convicted of setting at defiance the prohibition enacted by the XVIIIth Amendment.

Although the military censure of Spanish news is so complete that little of what is transpiring in the country reaches the outside world, it is reported from Gibraltar that serious unrest is spreading throughout Spain as to the outcome of the Morocco situation, regarded as grave in the war zone.

The «Shenandoah» airship disaster is the subject of official investigation in Washington D. C. more as to the responsibility for efficient organization under the Ministry of War, rather than into the possible causes of the disaster.

The fire losses in the United States are estimated as being five times per head of population the value of the London fires; figures which are causing the insurance companies to look into the present rates in force.

Battersea communists are vociferously protesting against the exclusion order issued by the American government against their parliamentary representative. The measure is generally approved by the British public.

With the departure of the Prince of Wales from Mar del Plata on Sunday next Argentine internal politics are likely to take on an extremely agitated phase, the Federal intervention of the Province of Buenos Aires being the most acute topic on the tapis.

Port News.

The «Voltaire» arrived yesterday morning, and the «Arlanza» from Europe is expected to arrive this morning at 5 a. m.

The passengers and mails from the «Voltaire» were landed yesterday.

The «American Legion» should sail for New York on Friday afternoon, passengers going aboard up to 5 p. m.

Within the next few days the Port Authorities expect to have the new discharging cranes working which have been acquired to replace those lost in the great storm of last summer. These new cranes will supply a great want, as for months unloading in the first dock has been greatly hampered due to want of these handling facilities.

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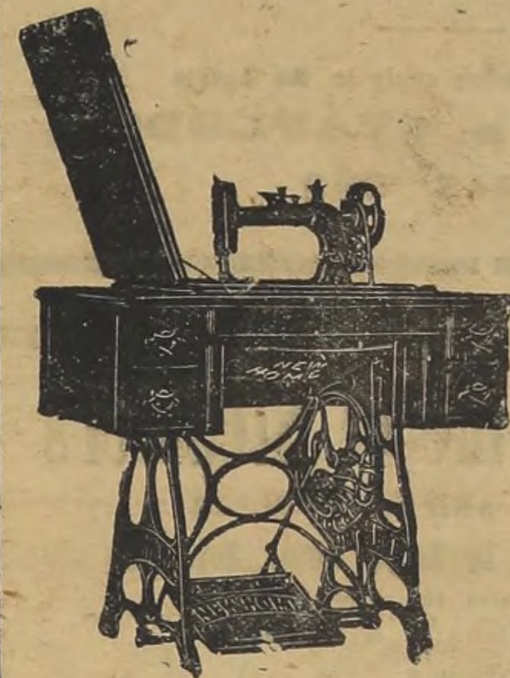
