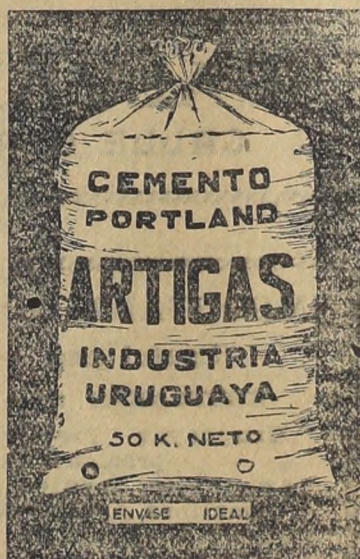

Cabled News.

THE MINISTERIAL CRISIS IN FRANCE.

Paris 24. The Executive Committee of the Socialist Party decided not to take part in the government of M. Briand.

M. Briand received this morning Messrs. Doumer, Herriot, Painslevé and Blum. He afterwards informed President Doumergue the result of his negotiations.

M. Briand declined the mission of forming the new Cabinet.

President Doumergue called M. Doumer to the Palace, at 16.20, and offered him the mission to form a new Cabinet. M. Doumer promised to give his answer within 24 hours.

M. Doumer allowed it to be known that if he accepted the formation of a Cabinet he should retain for himself the Ministry of Finance and Briand that of Foreign Affairs. The Socialists on knowing that M. Briand would be included in the Cabinet resolved to oppose the government composed by M. Doumer that includes in its programme the tax on capital.

The crisis led to the fall of the franc but not so heavily as was expected. It had at first a record fall to 126 per pound stg., but later on it improved to 124.56.

New York 24. Heavy sales of francs have given this money a record fall to 3.83 1/2. The Bill of Painslevé legalizing the increase of 150 millions of francs in the advances of the Bank of France and the corresponding danger of inflation have produced much nervousness in Stock Exchange circles. Bankers think energetic measures necessary to relieve the pressure of the internal debt.

FRANCE AND THE DRUSES.

Beirut 24. The military situation in Syria has improved for the French, who recently disembarked three thousand men including some coloured troops. They left for Sidon and Damascus with the idea of surrounding the rebels, in Hasbelya, where the Druses have their General Quarters.

The Druses evacuated Merjayun at 40 miles from Damascus. The French occupied Rachaya and the Druses retired with heavy loss. All day there has been a fierce fight in the valley of Bika, where the

Druses attacked two columns of the French who were going to Hasbelya. The Druses were defeated with great losses.

The French force amounted to 2,500 men. The French garrison in the citadel of Baselya of 259 men were liberated after an intense action against the Druses who retired towards Damascus after having suffered numerous losses.

New York 24. Miss Emilie Morhig, director of the Party pro-independence of Syria, declares that the rising against the French administration in Syria is national and not religious. She adds that: "The revolution is the result of the great injustice and despotic power of the French authorities."

THE VIOLINIST KREISLER THREATENED WITH DEATH.

New York 24. The New York *Sun* publishes a despatch from Berlin saying the famous violinist Kreisler has been threatened with death unless he pays 20,000 marks to the intimidators. Numerous police agents surround his house to protect him.

MYSTERIOUS REAPPEARANCE OF A VALUABLE LOST NECKLACE.

London 24. The pearl necklace valued at fifteen thousand pounds sterling which was lost and for the return of which a reward of a thousand pounds had been deposited in the post restante office for many months, has been found. The British and Canadian police had been hunting for it without avail for months. Now, an anonymous letter directed to Sam Blyth, son of the owner of the jewel, has been received in which it said that in the post office there awaited him a pleasant surprise. Said letter was sent to Scotland Yard who found the necklace intact and returned it to the owner.

TACNA AND ARICA.

Arica 24. Things seem to get worse everyday. It is now said that the withdrawal of the Peruvian boundary delegates is imminent. This is on account of a report presented by the Chilean Colonel Marchano who accuses the delegates of instigating the assassination of a Carabineer in Chayavientos.

Arica 25. At the last moment Pershing resolved to postpone the session of the Committee till further notice.

Washington 25. The cruiser *Denver* has been ordered to Arica. President Coolidge wishes General Pershing to remain in the disputed zone until the end of the plebiscite though the General had desired to return to the States for the Easter festivities.

THE LOCARNO PACT.

Berlin 24. The galleries of the Reichstag were filled when the discussion of the Locarno pacts took place. The opposition came principally from Nationalists. Luther spoke well to the point and Stressemann said that the only possible means of avoid-

ing the financial fall of Europe consisted in pacific cooperation with the other States.

London 24. The Prime Ministers who were to have come to London to sign the pacts will probably not come on account of the death of Queen Alexandra. Their places will be taken by the Ministers in London that represent those nations. This is in accordance with the suggestion of England to France.

GREECE WANTS CYPRUS.

Athens 24. The Grecian deputies recently elected for the National Assembly of Cyprus have telegraphed to the Colonial Office of Great Britain asking for the union of Cyprus with Greece. It is thought that Great Britain is agreeable to this so long as Italy will come to an arrangement with respect to Dodecaneso, and Great Britain is allowed an aviation station in Cyprus.

Memorial Service.

In connection with the lamented death of Queen Alexandra a special Memorial Service will be held in Holy Trinity Church on Friday morning next, the 27th inst. at 11 o'clock.

The Hon. E. S. Scott C.M.G., His Britannic Majesty's Minister in Uruguay will be present at this service, and it is presumed that it will be attended by official representatives of the Uruguayan Government.

The Late Queen Alexandra.

We have been courteously furnished by the British Minister with copies of the following cablegrams exchanged with the Foreign Office in connection with the death of Queen Alexandra.

(1) Copy of telegram sent by His Majesty's Minister to His Majesty's Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, dated the 22nd November, 1925:—

The Minister for Foreign Affairs asks me to convey the deep sympathy of the Uruguayan Government with the Royal Family and British people on the lamented death of Queen Alexandra. May I ask you to inform His Majesty that the sad news has been received with profound sorrow by all His loyal subjects here.

(2) Copy of telegram from His Majesty's Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, dated the 24th November:—

The King commands me to request you to convey to the Uruguayan Government His Majesty's most sincere thanks for their kind expression of sympathy. Please also express to the British community His

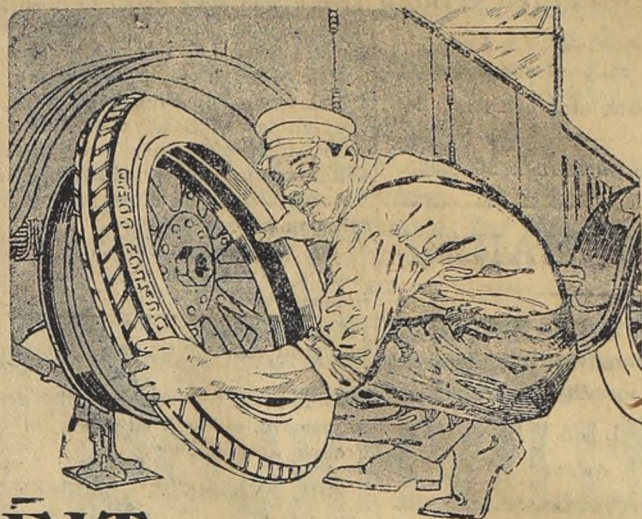

Majesty's appreciation of their sympathetic message

Thanksgiving Day.

There may be English speaking people scattered up and down the land who are unacquainted with to-day's celebration being a national event with United States Americans, but we doubt their being barred amongst the readers of *Times*:—there are some people writing with a quill pen who wonder if Lloyd George and King George are the same person.

For sixty years the Presidents of U. S. A., have annually issued a proclamation calling their fellow Americans to observe the fourth Thursday in November as a day of Thanksgiving, and barring the month of July possibly no other date is so generally observed throughout the country, the time for family reunion, or to what Christmas stands in England.

The ideal of such a celebration goes back to the first days of the American Colonies, and its present advance in most communities with religious service commemorates the piety of the old Puritan settlers, expressing gratitude after their harvest had been gathered in on the shores of the Massachusetts colony, which up to that time had been a scene of struggle with want and famine.

At intervals of years the observance of the event was made a matter of Presidential proclamation without being an annual affair, and it was until Lincoln's time in 1864

that it was made a regular official holiday.

From the harvest of 1621 to the balance sheet of national activities in 1925 is one of those enormous developments beyond the average comprehension of comparison,—but the originator's idea of the first Thanksgiving still holds good with a majority of the American people who to-day respond to their Chief Magistrate's invitation to give Thanks for the favours received as a nation during the past twelve months.

The *Times* associates itself heartily with its American friends in their compliance with President Coolidge's Proclamation.

Politics and Education.

One of the disadvantages of a small Republic is the great attention paid to politics and its interference with education. The party in power and the party out of power do all kinds of absurdities to obtain votes at elections, of one kind or another, that are continually "on the tapis".

Those in power for the nonce wish to strengthen their position to assure the continuance of their lucrative posts, and so they place square heads into round holes the square holes not being vacant, and consign to oblivion the round heads that would have just fitted nicely, because their politics are not exactly in conformity with their own.

In some posts it may not make much difference, because the real work of the highest post is usually accomplished by the understrappers, the head being purely ornamental. But in Education, or as this country prefers to call it Public Instruction,

the matter is of grave consequences.

A question is now calling the attention of the University Professors in which there appears to be an endeavour to go entirely against the law of the land to bring about a result in which most probably politics are the moving motives.

Our attention was once called to an event that illustrates the absurd lengths that political status is allowed to interfere with justice. An important post had to be filled. To fill it properly an expert was really demanded. A competitive examination was called for. Three examiners, each an expert in the matter under his jurisdiction, were cited to examine the candidates. Three of these attended. But one was so notably more suited to the post than the others, in fact it would have been difficult to have found another so absolutely competent for the post, that all three examiners unanimously pronounced in his favour and heartily congratulated him on his extraordinary talent. A week afterwards one of the examiners was called upon to examine another candidate who had not attended the first examinations. Two other examiners were cited also. The new candidate turned out far inferior to the one who so distinguished himself at the previous examination. And so the examiner who had attended both examinations explained in his decision against the new candidate. The new candidate, however was appointed to the post. Politics, we understand, was the motive. Not so much the politics of the man as those of his very useful (politically) father. \$60 had been spent quite unnecessarily in paying the examiners, but certain terms had to be gone through.

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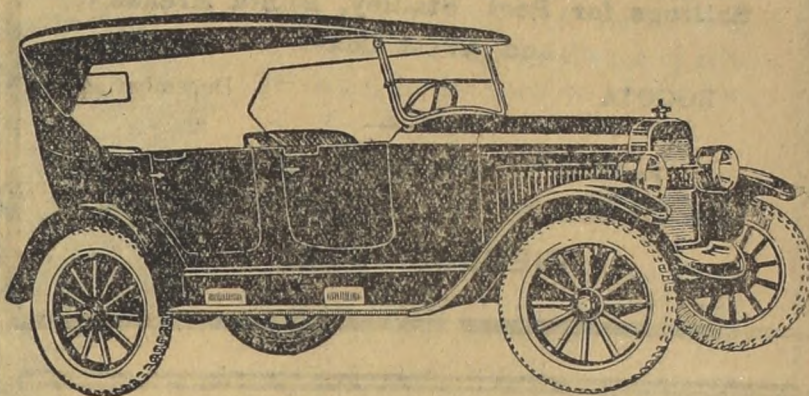
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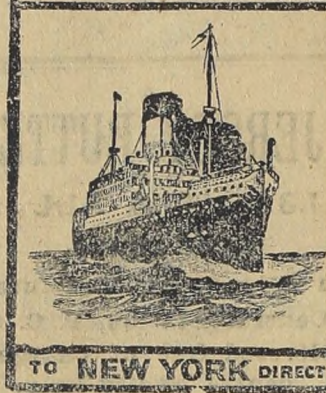
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
