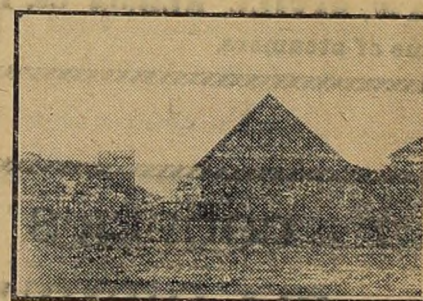

News of the Day.

Cabled News.

NEW BRITISH AEROPLANE.

London 15. The first tests of England's newest flying boat fitted with a stainless steel hull and two five hundred horsepower Napier engines were thoroughly satisfactory. She landed at Plymouth after a trip of 460 miles, and thence flew to Felixstowe some 370 miles further.

DUBLIN TO NEW YORK.

Dublin 15. The Free State Air Force is planning a flight to New York in 1926.

THE IRAQ OIL FIELD

Baghdad 15. All the wells in the Naftkhan field belonging to the Anglo-Persian Oil Company have been plugged awaiting the completion of transport facilities. It is estimated that these fields will produce one million tons of oil annually.

RECOGNITION OF SOVIETS.

Washington 15. Signs of the times point to the belief that the U. S. Government is slowly moving towards the recognition of the Russian Soviet Government.

TURKEY TO ABOLISH POLIGAMY.

Constantinople 15. The report of the Commission has been delivered, revising the law of the family. It includes provisions for the abolition of polygamy.

THREATS AGAINST BRITAIN.

Constantinople 15. The official newspaper after bullying England for her action at Geneva says: "Turkey will be obliged to take Mosul, not by mediation of the Nations, but by bayonets".

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE.

Stockholm 15. An enquiry into possibility of unemployment insurance is being made by a Government Commission of fifteen members, including 12 members of Parliament.

FRENCH NAVAL PROGRAMME.

Paris 15. The Minister of Marine M. Emile Borel says he intends to hurry up the execution of the programme of naval constructions, ad-

ding that France as a great naval and colonial power must be interested in her naval policy. It is true that the programme is a heavy financial charge, but its realization is a necessity, and its execution must be effected without delay. Said programme includes a cruiser of 2000 tons that will be launched shortly and will enter into service together with another unit of the same type in 1927.

In 1926 the construction will be commenced of units that will complete the number assigned in the programme.

NOTABLE FOSSILS FOUND IN CORDOBA.

Buenos Aires 15. Some important fossils have been found in Cordoba, including that of a *Panethus Suberculusus* of Pampean form and the hard shell of a much more ancient animal believed to be a *Hopelphorus Ornatus* of Pampean formation.

THE TACNA AND ARICA PLEBISCITE.

Arica 15. The Plebiscite Commission held a secret session of two hours yesterday, not communicating the result. The next meeting was fixed for tomorrow at the same hour.

ACTION IN MOROCCO.

Fes 15. Five more villages at the north east of Issoual have submitted to the French authorities. Together they form 140 families.

BATTLING SIKI THE SENEGALESE BOXER MURDERED.

New York 15. Siki, the ex-champion boxer, who beat Carpentier, has been picked up dead in an obscure street in New York. He had been shot in the head.

THE U. S. MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS SPEAKS.

New York 15. Mr. Kellogg declared before the parliamentary Committee of Foreign Affairs the foreign policy of the Government. It is very similar to that defended by Mr. Hughes, only it draws nearer to cooperation with Europe. For this approach the way was opened by the Dawes plan and the Locarno Pact. As regards European policy the Locarno Pact was the most important thing. With regard to China he said that she should be given a kind of government autonomy. He said: "I think the time has passed in which nations capable of governing themselves should permit the control or tutelage of foreign powers." Speaking of foreign loans he said Government did not wish to intervene in this matters. It will only decide on loans issued for unproductive purposes such as armaments. It will also try to restrict credit to those countries who have not consolidated their debts. He spoke of the measures adopted to prevent the entry into the country of undesirable foreigners, such as Count Karolyi and Mr. Daktalvala. The

U. S. have the right to prevent the entry of people who would initiate a dangerous propaganda against public order such as communism and revolutions.

THE CAMPAIGN AGAINST COMMUNISTS.

London 15. The Minister of the Interior has ordered Scotland Yard to prepare a report on the activities of foreign communists residing in Great Britain. Information says the foreign communists are acting as intermediaries for Moscow.

Bradford is considered a dangerous centre.

TACNA AND ARICA.

Arica 15. Edwards spoke extensively at the meeting of the Plebiscite Commission, reading the memorandum in which he answered General Pershing. The Chileans believe that when this is published public opinion will be convinced of the inconsistencies of the charges made by Pershing.

MORE TROUBLE IN IRELAND.

Belfast 15. The local police have risen in arms against the Dail Eirean, on account of the resolution of the latter about the Anglo-Irish treaty.

They demand compensation of 2,500,000 dollars in bonds, and to make their claim effective they have seized the deposits of munitions of Londonderry and Ballycastle.

The revolt has extended to Belfast, where the police occupied the barracks of the city, expelled the officers and took possession of the arms.

DEATH OF A FAMOUS PHYSICIAN.

London 15. Sir Richard Douglas Powell, the famous specialist in lung disorders died today. He was the private physician of Queen Victoria, Edward VII and George V.

GREECE AND BULGARIA.

Athens 15. The newspapers say that the Prime Minister Pangalos has declared that Greece is not at all inclined to pay Bulgaria the 30,000 levas as indemnization as ordered by the League of Nations. Still, he says, she is willing to pay for the damage caused by the troops in Bulgaria.

50 BISHOPS ARRESTED IN MOSCOW.

Berlin 15. It is announced that a new persecution of a religious character has commenced in Moscow where fifty bishops have been arrested.

MOSUL.

Geneva 15. An unconfirmed report says that at a secret session of the Council of the League of Nations the Council approved unanimously the provisional line fixed in Brussels as the definite frontier of Mosul, giving to England the mandate over the greater part of the Mosul for 25 years, in exchange

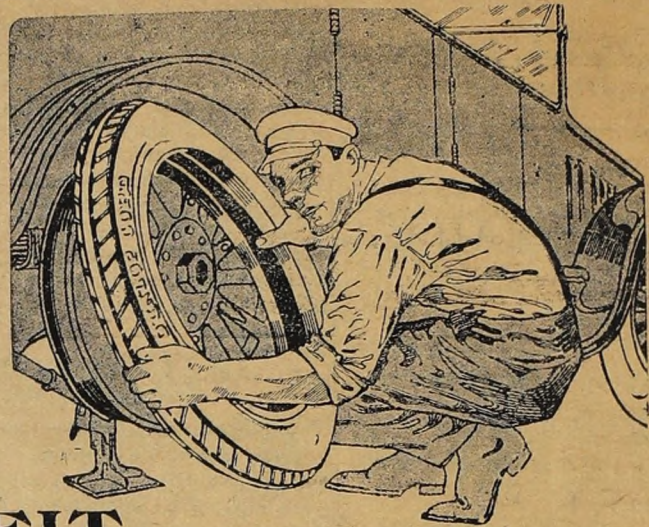

or economic treaties that favour Turkey.

The Secretary General of the League of Nations has published a supplementary report of the investigating Commission appointed to determine the conduct of the Turks in Mosul.

This document expresses that the Turks expelled from that region 100 Christians and committed any amount of atrocities for which a regiment of Turkish infantry is responsible.

The Council of the League has agreed to postpone the official announcement of their decision, so as to communicate with London to know if Great Britain is disposed to prolong her mandate over Mosul.

Through Argentine Spectacles.

(Continued from yesterday)

Now, it cannot be contended that Argentina has advanced to the very top in butter-making or in manufacture and production of any description. But it is making headway, and it is by no means on the bottom rung of the ladder. The foreign expert is welcomed with open arms. He generally manages to influence a little capital in this way. Taxation is heavy in Argentina and it is just as heavy in Uruguay, but here there is a clear desire to learn the most modern methods, to try everything once, to ask money, often in wildcat schemes, but, at least, to risk money. There is way open for the Uruguayans. This is to attract foreign worker, mechanic, farmer and capitalist. In

this connection, it may be said that Uruguay does not treat the capital that is already invested there hardly. It is realised that the investor must earn a decent dividend or will not leave his capital. But on the other hand, there appears to be a lukewarmness in the matter of welcoming the foreign worker. There are thousands of able Germans who could transform Uruguay in the course of a few years. There are thousands of Italians, Britons, and Russians, who only want a certainty that they will be allowed to take up land and work it for their own account. The neighbouring republic could harbour 20,000,000 souls without any difficulty, but it will never have that population unless a plan is adopted which will prove a magnet to the foreign worker. And with the advent of the foreigners the Uruguayans should adopt a policy of greater enterprise in commerce, trade and industry. Surely there is room for Uruguayan industry to make the articles which are to-day imported heavily from Argentina, and which could just as easily and cheaply be manufactured in Montevideo.

The pity of it is that the Uruguayans and even the foreign residents there appear to be extraordinarily antagonistic to foreign criticism, even though this be based on friendship and constructive lines. It is probable that what has been said above will not be taken in good part. «What right has a Buenos Aires paper to even discuss Uruguayan affairs?» This was the sort of feeling we run up against time and again. In the first place, of course, the topics of the whole

world are open to the journalist. In the second place, what has been written has been the result of looking on for a few days, and holds no animosity, very much the reverse in fact. And it should not be forgotten that the looker-on often sees most of the game.

The National Administrative Council.

The following amongst other matters were treated by the Council on Monday:—

The 45 million Loan: Dr. Terra having solicited that the study of the Bill for the Loan of 45 million dollars, should be terminated in time for it to be submitted to the consideration of the Legislative Body during the ordinary period which will commence in the month of February 1926, and having proposed a motion that the matter should be treated next Wednesday, his motion was passed.

Causes of infant mortality and the Conventillo: Dr. Herrera said that to the reasons mentioned in the previous session, as the causes of infantile mortality, must be added the wretched dwellings. It was necessary and urgent to insist, in the cities, that poor people should have better habitations, initiating an energetic campaign against the conventillo, which is a social shame. The physical misery, the bad atmosphere, the inhuman confinement in localities without water, without light and without services were perhaps the most powerful agents in infant mortal-

ity. The authorities ought not to allow the limit of capacity to be exceeded in the houses nor that rent should be collected for nauseous rooms. The conventillo is inconceivable with the culture of the Capital, and as far as their authority permits the National Council of Hygiene should dictate sanitary dispositions to oblige the proprietors to make modern installations that would allow the tenants to live decently. Sr. Lamas said that Municipal dispositions existed in this respect and that it was necessary to have them applied with all severity.

Items of Interest

More Light.

Once again the city is being lighted as the inhabitants have the right to demand, seeing the regularity with which a special municipal lighting tax is collected from the householders, and after having had the street lights cut down to every other lamp during the past six months, beginning Monday evening the full installation was

availed of to the surprise and satisfaction of everybody. One hardly dares to contemplate what would have been said and done if the Usina Electrica responsible for this suspended service, had been some foreign company, instead of an Official organization apparently able to act as it considers the situation demands when bills are not promptly paid for service rendered!

Capurro bathing beach.

There is trouble between the Municipality and the Transatlantica tram owning this bathing resort, and as a result the Beach is out of business. The residents of the northern sections of the city have asked the City authorities to arrive at some arrangement which will give them the facilities for bathing which the resort affords.

Fraud on the public debt office.

A daring forgery was committed recently, by which \$9800 was withdrawn from this Office, on the signatures of Judge Minelli and his actuary, in a probate proceeding. Police investigation is proceeding, and it should not be difficult to trace a fraud in which the principal factor must be an intimate acquaintance with the legal docket, at most times known to three or four people.

Early birds.

The National Council from date have decided that the office hours shall be from 7.15 am to noon. As a matter of curiosity it would be interesting to know how many employees, other than the doorkeepers, are likely to be found at their desks at 7.20 any morning

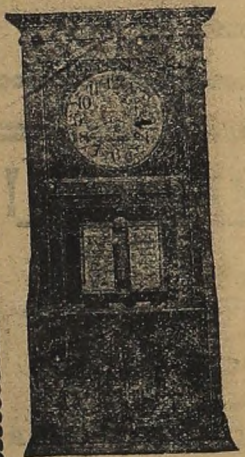

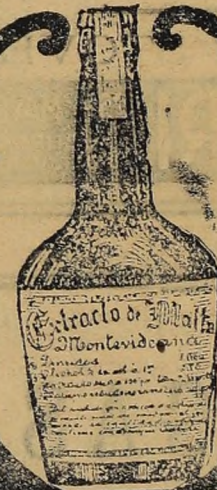

Tram service.

The Municipality are unable to pay one little peep to the celebrated Norte tram even when they discontinue their service altogether, simply because it is part of the State industrial system of «How to do Nothing», but when the Companies handling the tram service of the city do not adjust their running schedule to the ideas of every one of the sundry dozen municipal councillors, why, there is trouble, and lots of it! The Commercial have as good as told the City they can only perform the service they have the equipment for, and they cannot buy additional stock because they are not allowed to collect a fare which would give some return on the capital required for the investment. Possibly Montevideo is about the only city where monthly tickets and a four cent fare are still demanded under a charter of twenty years ago.

Conference in the Y. W. C. A.

This evening, Wednesday the 16th, at 9.50 p. m. in the gymnasium of the Young Women's Christian Association, Dr. Gaminara will give a lecture in the nature of a travelogue, accompanied by views of Washington, D. C. Many of our friends will remember another occasion on which Dr. Gaminara entertained us with his splendid views of New York City, and Niagara Falls. We hope all our members and many other friends will come.

Uruguayan Masonry.

Yesterday evening the Lodge «Libres Pensadores» held a brilliant ceremony at the Palacio Masónico to celebrate the entry of several adherentes, to which all regular masons were invited.

Tax on horse racing.

In the Consejo Nacional the question of taxing the betting tickets on horseraces came up. Sr. Narancio sustained that the tax which was said to apply only to the tickets on races in the Argentine should apply to all tickets on races. The question was not decided, however, the matter being left with the Minister for further study.

Abuses that might be remedied.

There is no doubt that the Municipality are improving the city of Montevideo with their new paved streets, however inconvenient it is being kept waiting in a tram car till a procession of cars pass from the opposite direction; but while they are about it they might keep these new streets free from loose paper blowing about to say nothing of the plazas. In fact the paper makers must be making a small fortune from the amount one sees pasted all over the city. Private houses are not exempt. They surely might know how it disfigures the city. Then there are two more abuses, committed by small boys, which could easily be remedied: the first is scribbling and scratching remarks, etc., on front doors and walls of private houses; the newer the door or wall is, the more it is abused, generally in sight of the police, as a set off.

The second abuse is the newspaper boys calling out their wares at the top of their voices, and in anything but a musical key, on board the trams to say nothing of blocking up the gangway.

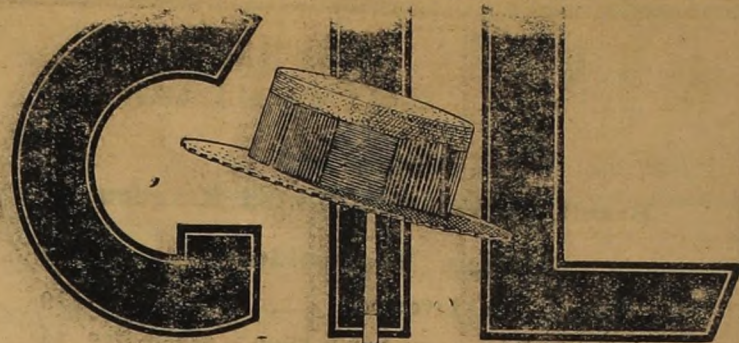

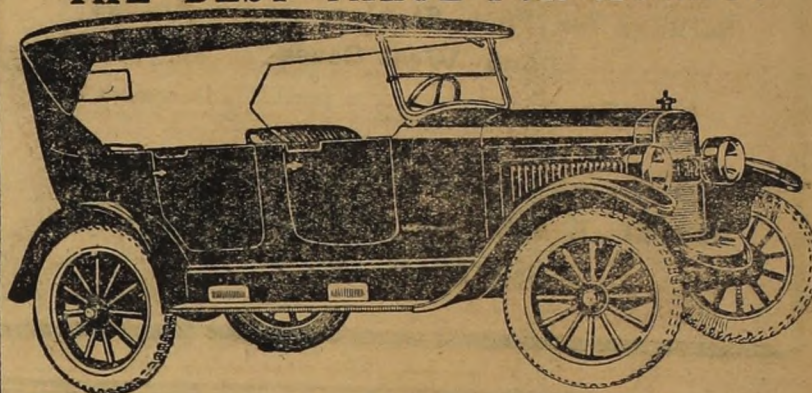

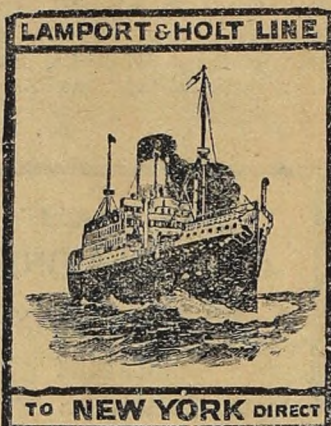
