nesses, came into force yesterday. At the Guildhall, a man who was charged with stealing various small articles belonging to his employer gave evidence, and was discharged. A man charged with assault at Greenwich Police-court called his wife as a witness. In this case the magistrate's decision was unfavorable to the accused. At Norwich Quarter Sessions a prisoner availed himself of the right conferred by the new statute, and judgment in his favour being affected by his evidence, it was remarked by the Recorder that that trial alone had justified the passing of this 'very beneficial Act of Parliament.' At some Courts the opinion was expressed that the Act does not come into force until to-day.

At Marylebone Police-court yesterday, the Hon. Phillip B. J. Petre was committed for trial on a charge of unlawfully obtaining, by means of false pretences, the sum of 20l., that being the amount of a cheque of his that was dishonoured after he had induced Mrs. Alice Coningsby, his former landlady, to cash it. Lord Petre was again accepted as bail for his brother in the sum of 100l.

So far the circumstances attending the murder of the window lady, Mrs. Tyler, on August 15, at her residence in Kidbrook-park road, Blackheath, are surrounded with mystery. The police have been unable to trace the perpetrator or perpetrators of the crime in any way, although there can be no doubt from the medical evidence that the unfortunate woman was strangled in her bedroom. The coroner's jury, after two adjournments, returned a verdict yesterday of willful murder against some person or persons unknown.

An inquiry into the circumstances attending the death of Mr. John Pattison, late proprietor of the Newington Rifle Range, was held yesterday at Guy's Hospital by Mr. A. C. Langham, the district coroner. The jury returned a verdict of willful murder against Walter John Simpson, an army reserve man, and a former employe of the deceased, who stands re-manded from Lambeth Police-court charged with shooting and wounding Mr. Pattison with a revolver.
