

direction he suggested work for the County Council. We had problems in India, in South Africa, and in all parts of the world, but the greatest problem of all was London. In respect to literature London's claim must not be put too high. It had attracted men of letters, but had often proved as a stepmother to them. If London could not merit more than in the past the attention of statesmen, he had the citizens determine that at least it should be worthy of its central position in the Empire, of its great history, and of its immeasurable future.

Labour trouble has arisen in the railway world. It appears that an appeal for the redress of certain grievances was recently addressed to all the companies. The London and North Western Company, apparently threatening to strike, have dismissed between 60 and 70 of their men. The Secretary of the Amalgamated Society of Railway Servants states that if these men are not reinstated within a week a strike will be declared.

The Queen won several prizes for cattle at the Smithfield Club Show yesterday. The champion of the entire show, however, was the Earl of Strathmore's Minx of Glamis, the polled Aberdeen Angus heifer which was champion at Birmingham.

Representatives of various counties met at Kensington Oval yesterday under the presidency of Sir Richard Webster, Attorney-General, and passed a resolution against the re-establishment of the County Cricket Council. In the Queen's Bench Division yesterday Sir W. C. Plowden obtained judgment for 1741 with costs against Prince Osoo Anneh (who came from Assam) last year claiming to be the representative of the King) balance of a sum due for rent, etc., of a house in Park-road, Regent's park, which the defendant took for 16 weeks.

Mr. Thomas Bowling, a master mariner, obtained a decree nisi in the Divorce Division, with cost and the custody of the children, by reason of the adultery of his wife with his brother, Mr. Alfred Bowling, who is a master mariner. In May, 1895, the petitioner went on a voyage to the Cape of Good Hope, parting with his wife on affectionate terms. When he returned he found that his wife and brother had left taking the youngest child with them.

At the County of London Sessions, Clerkwell, a young man named William Pugh was sentenced to eighteen months' imprisonment for detaining a money-lender at Queen Victoria street. This was not the first time he had been convicted of a similar offence, and it was stated that with his brother he had obtained something like 9,500l. by fraud from money-lenders.

The man Miller, or Hamlyn, was yesterday committed for trial from the Guildhall on charges of having obtained large sums of money through the alleged "perfection" system of investment. He was then further proceeded against by Mr. Muir for having taken part in supposed frauds by missing word competitions in this country, and by means of correspondence abroad. Evidence in support of this fresh part of the case having been given, the hearing was adjourned.

Owing to the continued illness of Frederick Kest, one of the defendants, the trial of Lady Scott and three others, charged with publishing false and defamatory libel upon Earl Russell, could not be proceeded with yesterday at the Central Criminal Court. Evidence was given by the prison doctor that Kest was too ill to attend, and probably could not be present, in the event of his recovery, for another three weeks. It was decided to adjourn until January 4th. An application for bail for the male defendants Cookerion and Aylott was successful, and the men were later in the day released from custody, their proffered sureties having been regarded as satisfactory. Kest remained in critical condition last night.
