—We note that Mr. R. K. Theodor is the winner of the 3rd prize in the shooting competition that has been held at Pontos.

—Mr. Bayard, the U.S. Ambassador in England, has again been "cautioned" by the U.S. Secretary of Foreign Affairs on account of the political allusions in his speeches.

—The heat yesterday was terrific. Fortunately the wind was not in the north.

—Sr. José Palmer, proprietor of the shoe shops Calle 18 de Julio 280, dropped down dead while crossing the patio of his house, about 10 o'clock on Monday morning. He lived there alone, but his sister-in-law Sr. F. S. de Palmer happened to be in the house at the time and saw him fall.

—A day break yesterday, a fisherman named Silvestre Stampa was very seriously stabbed by another named Pedro Albano, in the course of a business quarrel. The weapon used was a large knife for cleaning the fish. This occurred on the fishermen's wharf in Calle Orillas del Plata, the frequent scene of disorders, many of the fishermen being normally and savage Napolitans.

—The Siglo thinks that the sanitary authorities ought to take energetic measures to prevent the introduction of the bubonic plague into Uruguay.

—Carmelo Cabrera, the last prisoner on account of the terrible bomb conspiracy, was released on bail yesterday. Perhaps the affair will now be allowed to die out.

—The Minister of War returned from Colonia yesterday.

—On Monday afternoon a rash young woman named Amelia Franco, feeling hungry, made a meal of 25 hard peaches and 2 pomegranates. She is now repeating her exuberant appetite in the Caridad Hospital. One or two more such cases and some idiot will raise a scare of cholera.

—Queen Victoria has given £1500 from her private purse towards relief of the distress in India. Rain has fallen in some of the famine stricken parts, but more is wanted yet. The bubonic plague continues to extend.

—The Havana correspondents of some principal Madrid papers have been withdrawn as an act of protest against the arbitrary treatment by the Spanish Government of the papers in question.

—The famous "Chat Noir" at Paris has been definitely closed.

—The Czar and Czarina will shortly visit King Humbert at Rome.

—There have been more deaths from cholera on board the "Nubia" in quarantine in Plymouth harbour.

—The German Government has determined to establish a consulate at Johannesburg.

—Sweden and Denmark intend taking steps to proclaim their neutrality in case of an European war. They will be supported by Russia and France.

—An international demonstration in honour of Herbert Spencer is being arranged to celebrate the completion of his great philosophic work. He is now 76 years old and in feeble health.

were working upon her at the time, and four of them were drowned. The others managed to scramble ashore.

There were good supplies of cattle and sheep at the London Christmas market yesterday. Prices generally were below the figures touched a year ago.

An appeal from Scotland decided by the House of Lords involved and interesting question with regard to the conduct of tramway traffic in winter. Mr. James Ogden, a manufacturer in Aberdeen, sought to have the local tramway company interdicted from so removing snow from their lines to the traffic, and also from scattering salt on the lines in time of snow. The company contended that if the snow and ice were not so removed tramway traffic must be stopped. Their lordships ruled that the action of the company had proved an obstruction to street traffic, that a nuisance was caused on the public highway by their operations in clearing away the snow, and that they were not relieved from a responsibility in reference to this by any statutory power they possessed. Judgment was therefore in favour of the appellant with costs.

Mr. Laugham, the City Coroner, held an inquest yesterday at Holloway Gaol on the body of Frederick East, one of the defendants in the Scott libel case, who had died in the infirmary at that institution. The evidence showed that death was due to inflammation of the lungs, and the jury found a verdict in accordance with the medical testimony. To that verdict, however, they added a rider that better provision should be made at the goal for prisoners on remand who were in the infirmary. During the proceedings there was a heated discussion between solicitors representing different parties to the Scott libel case as to the admissibility of a portion of the evidence relating to a remark said to have been made by East in prison about that case.

An inquest was held at Chelsea yesterday with reference to the death of Mrs. Caroline Le Champignon, a lady 21 years of age, who committed suicide by taking a quantity of laudanum at her lodgings in Oakley-street on Friday. The deceased was the petitioner in a matrimonial suit which recently occupied the attention of Sir Francis Jeune, who granted her an order for judicial separation on the ground of the cruelty of her husband. An appeal had, however, been entered, and the child had been made a ward in Chancery. It was suggested that separation from the child had been a source of worry to the deceased, and the jury found that she committed suicide while of unbalanced mind.

LONDON NOTES.

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 15.

Yesterday being the anniversary of the death of the Prince Consort and of Princess Alice, the Queen and many members of the Royal Family attended a special memorial service at the Royal Mausoleum, Frogmore. The choir of St. George's sang a hymn and anthems under the direction of Sir Walter Parratt.

A Rome Correspondent learns that the Italian Government has been asked by Lord Salisbury what its attitude would be in the event of Great Britain, France, and Russia uniting to impose force on the Sultan. A similar question has been addressed to the other members of the Triple Alliance.

It is stated from Washington that the negotiations for a general Arbitration Treaty are expected to be concluded within three weeks. The operations of the Treaty, it is believed, will be limited to a certain number of years.

Addressing the York Liberal Four Hundred last night, Sir Frank Lockwood, Q. C., M. P., devoted a considerable portion of his speech to the questions which might occupy attention in the coming session of Parliament. They had a right, he said, to expect at the outset a very frank and full statement of the precise position in relation to the various foreign complications that had occurred. As to the Education question the Liberal party knew where they were, but he was not at all sure that the Tory or Unionist party were in the same happy position. They had not had much light given them as to the mode in which the question was to be dealt with, but he believed the Government had done no attempt to give rate aid without public control. A question which might occupy considerable time was that of the financial relations between Ireland and England. If the report of the Commission could be relied on they had been doing grievous wrong towards Ireland. It seemed to him that the Government had a great opportunity of doing something to relieve the unfair advance under which the sister island had been labouring for a considerable time.

The Hon. W. P. Reeves lectured at the Imperial Institute last evening on the Hot Lakes District of New Zealand, which he described as of great value to the invalid.

While the screw steamer Orontea, belonging to the Pacific Steam Navigation Company, was coaling in Tilbury Dock yesterday she suddenly capsized. Nearly three hundred men
