LONDON NOTES

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 14. The list of wrecks and loss of life round the coast in the recent gale is being continually added to. Further heavy floods have occurred in Somersetshire, the River Parrett having again overflowed its banks, and it is feared that the area which previously suffered will be a worse plight than ever.

The Rev. R. Randolph Suffield, the eminent Roman Catholic priest who for the last twenty years had been a Unitarian minister, died at his residence at Reading yesterday. A New York Correspondent, in an interesting letter on the operation of the McKinley tariff, shows that it has resulted in increased prices and lower wages.

We learn from Moscow that sixty persons belonging to the nobility, the literary profession, and the upper middle classes have been arrested for conspiracy. They are charged with organizing a political party to agitate for the creation of a Territorial Assembly.

There were sixteen starters for the Liverpool Cup yesterday. Madame d'Albany won easily, coming in three lengths ahead of Merry-Lady Rosebery was a bad third. The Downe Nursery Handicap fell to Lady Morgan, the Waverley, Welter Handicap to Don Quixote, the Antree Hunt Steeplechase to Tashy, the Daily Plate to Roy Nell, the Palatine Plate to Jim Rose, and the Aigburth Plate to Narrator.

Justice Mathew and Smith, sitting in the Queen's Bench Division, granted a rule calling upon the Mayor of Eastbourne to show cause why a writ of certiorari should not issue to bring up for trial at the Central Criminal Court from the Sussex Assizes indictments found against members of the Salvation Army for disturbing the peace at Eastbourne.

Some remarkable evidence was given at the North London Police-court during the hearing of a charge of being concerned in a burglary at 18, Douglas road, Canonbury, preferred against a labourer named Ganner. The prisoner had been smartly captured by some young gentlemen, Messrs. Legg, who lived in the house, and most of the property stolen had been recovered.

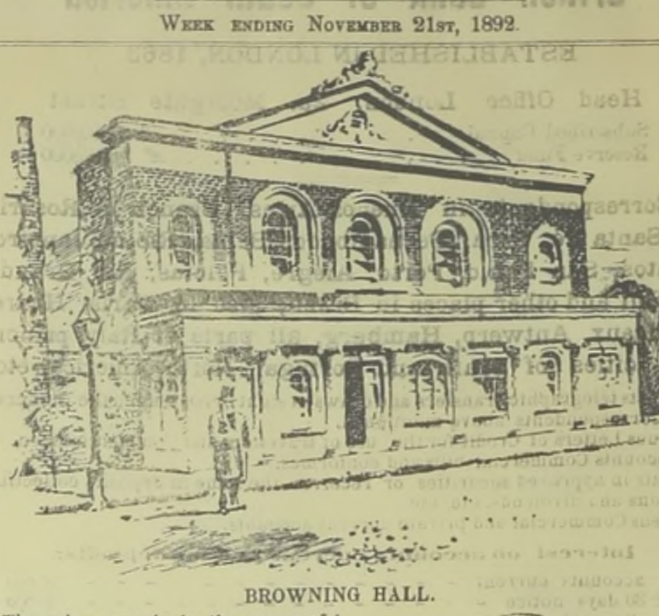
