MONDAY, NOVEMBER 28.

The Queen, accompanied by Princess Henry of Battenberg, arrived at Windsor on Saturday from Balmoral. The Princess of Wales with her daughters the Princesses Victoria and Maud have arrived at Marlborough House from Russia.

Mr. Goschen delivered his rectorial address before the students of Edinburgh University Thursday. He took for his subject the 'Use of Imagination in Study and in Life.'

At the last meeting of the present School Board for London, yesterday, Sir Richard Temple, M. P. (Chairman of the Finance Committee), made his half-yearly statement. He said it seemed probable that the taxation next year must be at a rate of at least elevenpence in the pound on an assessment of about thirty-three millions of rateable value for the metropolis.

Captain Cheswynd's official report upon the disasters and loss of life attending the launching of the Lydd and Sandgate lifeboats during the recent gale was given at Hythe yesterday. Practically it was to the effect that the coxswains and crews acted in a judicious, seamanlike, and creditable manner.
