

LONDON NOTES.

SATURDAY, JULY 25.

The House of Commons by sitting till a quarter to five yesterday morning passed the Irish Land Bill through the Committee stage.

Lord Rosebery, opening a new technical institute and art school at Epsom yesterday, devoted the greater part of his address to a review of the rapid strides made in recent years by Germany in commercial competition with this country.

A correspondent at Bisleigh shows that considerable excitement was caused in camp yesterday by a fire amongst the heather, not twenty yards from the powder magazine.

War was declared about two o'clock yesterday between the two fleets now out for the naval manoeuvres. The fleets are commanded on the Channel side by Lord Walter Kerr and Admiral Powlett, and on the Reserve side by Admiral Seymour and Admiral Wilson.

Against the Australians at Lord's yesterday the M.C.C. carried their first innings score to 367, or 165 to the good. In their second attempt the visitors put on 113 runs for two wickets.

Further fighting has taken place in Rhodesia. A force under Captain Nicholson has engaged the enemy in the Matopos Hills, but, after an attack lasting two hours, had to desist, the Matabele refusing to be drawn from their positions.

A telegram from Capes states that panic continues to prevail there. The Christian shops remain closed, and the Assembly held only one sitting, many of the Deputies being afraid to venture into the town.
