She was so glad, in her loneliness, of the companionship; his manner was always so matter-of-fact in his thoughtful care of her, that she soon felt towards him something of the simple confidence she would have given to an elder brother.

For the grim, disappointed man could be the most amusing and delightful of companions when he chose; and he chose to be so with her. Though the shame and bitterness of his married life—and it was a greater shame than even the prying curious world knew—had been gradually warping his nature, there was something in this fragile, sensitive girl, with her absurd air of youthfulness, but with her fine powers of self-control, her quiet courage and patient endurance, which slowly awakened those softer, truer chords in his heart that had been jarred all out of tune by the horrible shame and degradation of his domestic life.

The friendly, half-professional interest which he first took in her gradually deepened into a tender liking yet still such as he might have felt for a young sister needing his protection and care.

Of the priest she saw much less. Yet he, too, relaxed from his ascetic coldness and aloofness, to show her a kindly attention which surprised her. She had heard a good deal about him from outsiders, and was amused to discover that she was looked up with jealous and envious eyes by many of his fair devotees, for enjoying the honour of living under the same roof. He was generally held, if not as a saint, as something very nearly approaching one, and venerated and adored accordingly. This intonation and blind subservience disgusted Daphne, who yet felt vividly the power of his personality.

The mystery of his presence at Whitefriars, of his life of austere self-renunciation, added the general interest that he aroused. It was rumoured that more than once some good living, some influential appointment had been offered to him, only to be declined. His great intellectual gifts, his eloquence, and still more, marvellous powers of influencing men and women of all ranks and conditions of life, the purest and finest as well as the most ignorant and degraded, marked him as a man fit for the highest preferment. Yet he lived here, contented to take the lowest place, willing to do the humblest service, always ready to go out to the help and the saving of the most degraded. Peter Vance was one of those rescued ones. Father Montfort had lifted the man out of the mire of shameful self-indulgence and degradation, and Peter's gratitude was in proportion to the Father's efforts to save him. The priest had done a magnificent work in Millford, both in the slums and high places; and a certain vague impression, formed no one knew how, that on his past lay a dark shadow of suffering, or even of some great sin, in no way militated against the universal belief in his present goodness. If he had suffered, then all honour to the man who could sink his own sorrows in those of his fellow-creatures. It had been sinned, then nobly had he made expiation for it. Indeed, this faint suggestion of a dark and troubled past which had gathered about him, deepened rather than lessened the interest that he had inspired. When Daphne first heard the rumour repeated to her by the kind old lady, Miss Dare, with whom she was more intimate than with any of her other acquaintance, she wondered if that secret of the past had anything to do with the hatred between the two cousins. This hatred was a continual source of regret to her. She liked the two men so well that she could not bear the thought of so debasing a passion darkening their relations to each other. Thus side by side with the secret cares and anxieties, the ceaseless tasks of her daily life, ran this current of friendly interest which, far more than she knew, mitigated her loneliness, and gradually took possession of the empty spaces of her life under her uncle's roof. Though his cousin plainly objected to it, she went to the church-21 which Father Montfort usually officiated; and also, whenever she could, she attended the mission services he was conducting in another and poorer part of the town.
