The second trial of the matricide Chanez took place yesterday, and was very prompt. He was again found fully guilty, and accordingly the Tribunal of Appeal confirmed the death sentence of the first trial. We presume this is final, but it remains to be seen whether the sentence will be carried out.

About 3 a. m. on Sunday, the British str. «Alacrité», from Rosario for England with wheat, ran on the hidden stone bank known as «Pancala» about 11 miles W. of S. José point and 5 of Espinillo. Advice was received in this port at daybreak, and Lusich's salvage tugs immediately went to the scene. After hard work of over 24 hours, they got her off yesterday morning. We cannot yet say how far she has been damaged. The «Alacrité» is a Hartlepool steamer of 2190 tons net, and was consigned to Christophersen Brothers. Captain Thomas Taylor.

Mr. Chamberlain is now visiting Dublin, where he is to receive the Rectorship of the University. According to the telegrams, his reception there has been purely formal and very cold, though the pro-Boer meeting organised by the Nationalists was a failure. (Mr. Chamberlain was waiting in tact to visit Ireland just now.)

The German Emperor writes in a new book at Leipzig, called «The Golden Book of the German People at the Turn of the Century»: «By God's grace is the King, therefore he is only answerable to the Lord alone. He may only choose his way and his work from this standpoint. This fearfully serious responsibility, which the King bears for his people, gives him also a right to the faithful co-operation of his subjects. Therefore every single person must be imbued with the conviction that he, on his part, is responsible for the Fatherland's welfare.» Prince Hohenlohe inscribed the following words: «Fortiter in re, suaviter in modo.» Count Billew wrote: «The ultimate object of policy is to succeed in making individuals consciously subordinate their selfishness to the object recognised as useful for the community.» The President of the Reichstag, Count Ballestrem, wrote: «Do right and fear no one; but really no one, neither high nor low.»

A pretty story respecting the Queen's first visit to Bristol, 69 years ago, is told on apparently good authority. With her mother she entered a china shop in High street, to buy a doll's dinner service. The one that captivated her fancy was too dear for her childish purse, but, in spite of early lessons of economy, she still wished to purchase it. Thereupon a consultation took place between her and her mother, ending in a triumph for the young Princess, the Duchess of Kent consenting to lend her the amount wanted until her next allowance should be due. Our future Queen carried off the precious tea-set with great joy. The shop was kept by Miss Elizabeth Ring, a Quaker lady, a relative of whom is responsible for the story.

LONDON NOTES.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 20.

A tea-concert organized by Mrs. Brown Potter and other American ladies for the funds of the hospital ship Maine was held at Clarendon Hotel on Saturday. It was a brilliant success. The Prince of Wales and other members of the Royal Family were present.

Sir M. W. Ridley, the Home Secretary, has framed a scale of allowances to be made to those dependent upon Army Reservists who are members of the Metropolitan Police Force during their absence in South Africa. It is his intention to introduce a Bill at the earliest date for granting the necessary statutory power. The measure will apply to all police forces in the country, and give covering authority for allowances granted in anticipation of the passing of the law.

Preaching yesterday morning in Christ Church, Newgate-street, on the Reformation in Queen Elizabeth's reign, the Bishop of London said Elizabeth ten years after her accession was quite clear there had been no revolution; the State was not the Church's master, but had only freed it from a foreign tyrant.

During a heavy fog on Saturday morning a railway collision occurred half a mile from the Central Station, Manchester. Over twenty persons were injured.

An attempt was made on Saturday to tow the burning German liner Patria to sea, and ran her on the English coast, but when off Walmer Castle yesterday morning she sank stern first in seven fathoms of water. Edward Beall was, at the Central Criminal Court, on Saturday, sen-

Charles Singleton was sent to prison for eighteen months, and William J. Carruthers-Wain for twelve months, both in the second division. Thomas Harrison Lambert was found not guilty.

Fog greatly interfered with football on Saturday. Only four matches in the League Championship could be played to a finish; but one of these enabled Sheffield United to further strengthen their position at the head of the table. Aston Villa managed to make a draw with Liverpool. Another round of the English Cup competition was run through. The best thing in club games was the contest at West Kensington, in which the Corinthians beat the Queen's Park (Glasgow) team by two goals to one.

In the Rugby section there was a victory for Devon over Gloucestershire in the County Championship; while Blackheath drew with Cambridge University. Oxford beat the Harlequins, and London Scottish gained a brilliant victory over Richmond.

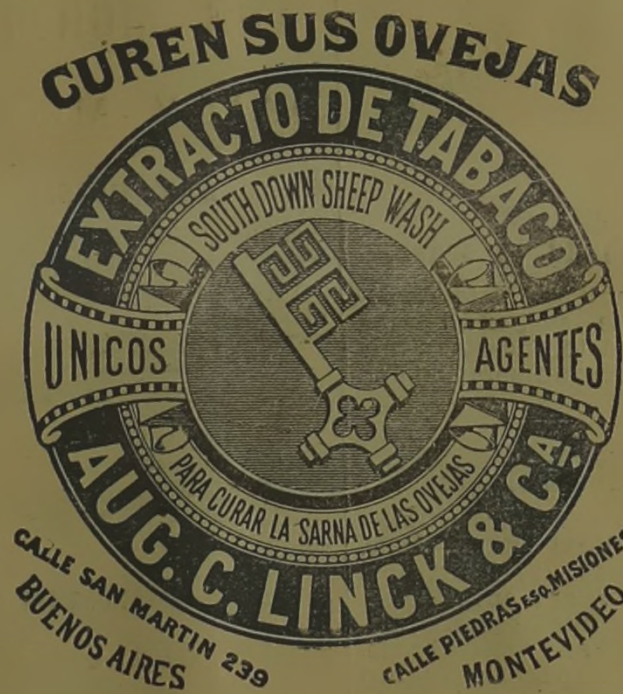
